Dear Parent / Carer,

You may be aware from previous correspondence that the school is going to be providing food hampers to local charity organisations and nominated individuals this Christmas. Each tutor group in the school will be collecting items over the next week, and they will be delivered by students, under the supervision of staff, on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December.

We are therefore asking students to bring in one or more items as a contribution to these hampers. We would ask that any contributions are not perishable, do not require freezing or refrigeration and are not alcoholic. We are also conscious that we would like to provide some variety, and so ideas may include dried foods, soups, canned vegetables, pies, meats and fish, snacks, cereals, biscuits, cake, tea and coffee and other soft drinks. Clearly this list isn't exhaustive.

In return for your son's (and your) generosity, we are holding a non-uniform day on the last day of term, Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December. All students who contribute to the hampers will be allowed to wear non-uniform (hopefully including a Christmas jumper) on this day. Those choosing not to contribute will be asked to donate £1 for the privilege instead.

Contributions are welcome any time from now until Wednesday, and hampers will be prepared on Wednesday for delivery on Thursday.
