

GCSE Examination Results 2021

GCSE results will be available for collection from the main school hall on Thursday 12th August 2021 between 9am and 10am. Staff will be available on the day to offer praise and support.

If you are unable to collect your results you can nominate a family member to collect on your behalf. You must provide signed written confirmation of this arrangement. The nominated family member must bring identification with them in order for the results to be released. We cannot release the results without written consent and without prior arrangement. Please advise Miss Worrall the Examinations Officer if you are unable to collect your results prior to results day.

Due to data protection regulations we are unable to give results over the telephone.

Appeals

The joint Council of Qualification (JCQ) confirmed that all students have the right to appeal their Teacher Assessed Grades. Appeals can only be submitted on the grounds of administrative or procedural errors.

Appeal will not be accepted because students are not happy with their grade.
