**Year 7 English and Maths Catch-Up 2017-18**

Catch-up funding is available for students not meeting the 'expected standard' scaled score of 100 in reading and/or Maths.

There are 16 students who did not meet the expected standard in Maths, and 24 in English.

For 2017-18 KNBS receives approximately £10,500. Year 7 catch-up funding at KNBS is being targeted to software packages and interventions, but as always, the most effective way to challenge under achievement at all levels is through 'Quality First Teaching'.

<b>Accelerated reader</b>	This package is designed to give teachers the information they need to monitor students' reading practice and to make informed decisions to guide their future learning. Students are quizzed after reading an appropriately levelled book, and this helps to develop skills in comprehension as well as bringing a fun, competitive element to their reading.	£3000	Y7 literacy

<b>JustMaths online</b>	Online maths resource <b>Pro rata of overall cost</b>	£50	Y7 numeracy.
<b>PiXL Maths App</b>	Setting and tracking homework, videos and tests. <b>Pro rata of membership</b>	£100	Y7 numeracy.
<b>Electronic Calculators and other sundries</b>		£100	Y7 literacy.
<b>One to One intervention</b>	Before October half term 3 TAs, after half term 5 TAs. Use of the above packages as well as reading and discussion based activities.	£1500	Y7 numeracy and literacy.
<b>HLTA teaching 3 periods per fortnight of Y7 LPA maths and leading on Numeracy (Extra 8K salary)</b>	Using predominantly PIXL resources "Arithmetic Improvement", AM suspends much of the regular scheme of work to concentrate on PLC based work from PiXL.	£3000	Y7 numeracy.
<b>Appointment of TA to lead on literacy (Extra £5K salary)</b>	For co-ordination of literacy activities across predominantly KS3. <b>Pro rata of salary.</b>	£2300	Y7 literacy.
